# Using GDPR to Prepare for CCPA, and Vice-Versa

Two of the most important global developments in privacy are the European Union's General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the California Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA). The two requirements share certain common elements, but also differ in noteworthy ways.
